Choose an article from a newspaper, website, or magazine. The article must be about a current issue. Sports articles are not permitted. Please make sure to print or cut the article out and attach it to your work to turn in. If you are submitting this digitally please provide the link for your article. Then you must complete one of the following assignments.

Reporter:

Rewrite the article as if you are the reporter. Retell the events from your point of view. slide orientation

Perspective:

Rewrite the article as if you are one of the people involved in this event. Make sure to include your feelings and how this impacts their life.

Ethics:

What moral principles are included in this subject? What controversies exist? What does our faith teach us about this? Make sure to include more than one side of the argument. Then explain what your thoughts are.

All projects must contain the following information You can put this information within the assignment or include it in the beginning of it.

- **Title of article**
- **Author of article**
- **Date of article**
- **Summary of article that includes Who, What, Where, When, and Why.**
- **Your opinion of this issue or event. (How does this relate or impact you)**

Timeline:

Create a timeline of the events contained in the article. Make sure to have at least 12 events. Each event should have a picture and a caption.

Fact Vs. Opinion:

What are some of the unanswered questions in this article(2)? List 3 examples of facts and 3 examples of opinions that you found in the article.

Letter to the Editor:

Write a letter to the editor of this Newspaper. In it you need to explain your opinion of the article. Make sure to support your opinion with facts and explanation.

Political Cartoon:

Create a political cartoon encompassing the events contained in the article. That your images are neat, colorful, and creative. You should include captions and dialogue.
